



**The Canadian Renewable Fuels Summit's Call for Technical Papers Is Now Open**

***The Canadian Renewable Fuels Association will be holding its 10th Annual Summit on December 2-4, 2013 in Montreal.***

OTTAWA, Ontario, June 19, 2013 – The Canadian Renewable Fuels Association (CRFA) has announced the call for technical papers for its 10th Annual Canadian Renewable Fuels Summit (CRFS). The CRFS is the premiere national conference for liquid renewable fuels in Canada. This year, the Summit's theme will examine the important role of domestic biofuels in "Fuelling Growth and Innovation".

To help mark its 10th Anniversary, the CRFA is inviting submissions for technical papers describing unpublished research and materials. Possible research categories are:

- New Biofuels Technologies
- New Pathways to Utilization
- Novel Feedstocks
- LCA and Emissions Impacts
- New Biofuels and Co-products
- Biotechnology - Bridging Feedstocks, Biofuels and Bio-products
- Infrastructure and Downstream Use

Submissions will be reviewed by Canadian academics and the top three entries will be invited to present their papers at the CRFS in Montreal. The winning author will be recognized during the Green Fuel Awards ceremony on December 4, 2013.

"For the first time in the history of the CRFS, we are inviting submissions for technical papers," said Deborah Elson, Vice President Membership, Stakeholder Relations and Industry Promotions. "This initiative is a wonderful opportunity to explore our collective energy future and learn more about the many ways that biofuels can protect our environment and grow our bio-based economy."
